

Exemption from MBCuk Courses

Increasingly aspirant coaches and leaders are coming into the MBCuk Scheme with a wealth of previous experience and learning; Examples are Servicemen and women, Teachers, and Outdoor-Instructors with time served in transferable coaching and leadership roles.

At all levels throughout the MBCuk Scheme exemption from training and Assessment can be applied for, to reduce the number of modules, and or transfer to a shortened course so as not to repeat already established current skills and learning.

Exemption can be applied for using Accreditation for Previous Experience and Learning (APEL) if:

- You hold a relevant and recognised teacher Instructor qualification
- You hold a relevant and recognised coaching qualification
- You have previous experience in leadership
- You have a proven ability in a specific transferable skill (first aid, navigation, cycle maintenance etc)

A copy of the relevant current qualification skill or competency should be submitted to info@mountainbikecoaching.com which will be assessed against the relevant Course Training Plans CTP's by the MBCuk Panel.
